

## **OPERATORS GUIDE**

**Soft Touch Clamps** 

#### **CLAMP MAINTENANCE**

DAILY - Ensure the bladder pressure stays within the green zone (4-6 psi).


If out of green zone, adjustment must be made by trained personnel.

Refer to the Bladder Fill Instructions in the "Technicians Guide".

#### **CLAMP OPERATION**


#### Step 1:

- 1-1) Stop in front of the load, tilt mast vertical.
- 1-2) Align the bottom of the attachment to bottom of the load.



#### Step 2:


- 2-1) Square the truck to load and open the arms for clearance.
- 2-2) Align by sideshifting.




#### Step 3:

3-1) Drive forward to engage the load. See illustrations below for proper load handling.

Clamped product should be positioned so that the load is even





### TRAILER UNLOADING - APPROACH ANGLE



#### STANDARD CARTON CLAMP OPERATION

- Standard Carton Clamps allow a large approach angle because the pads will rotate and align with the trailer wall.
- With this large approach angle, the pad closest to the wall will make contact far before the load is reached.



### **LORON SOFT TOUCH CLAMP OPERATION**

- The allowable approach angle with a Loron Soft
  Touch Clamp is significantly reduced. The operator
  must drive in close-to-parallel with the trailer wall.
- Do not contact the wall before the corner of the load is reached.
